There is nothing I enjoy so well as feasting in a great hall;

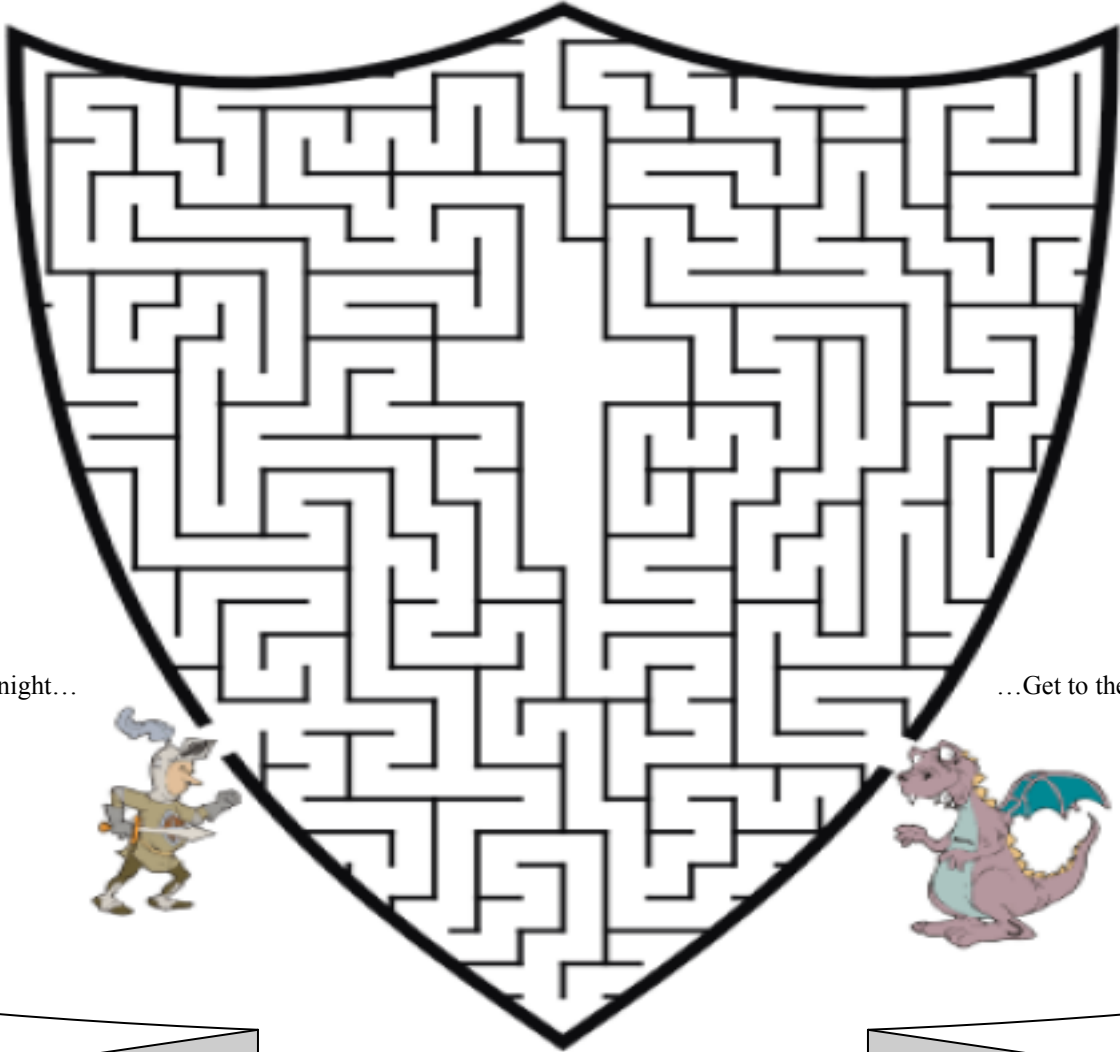
Fires blazing, music playing,

And throwing the bones to the dogs.

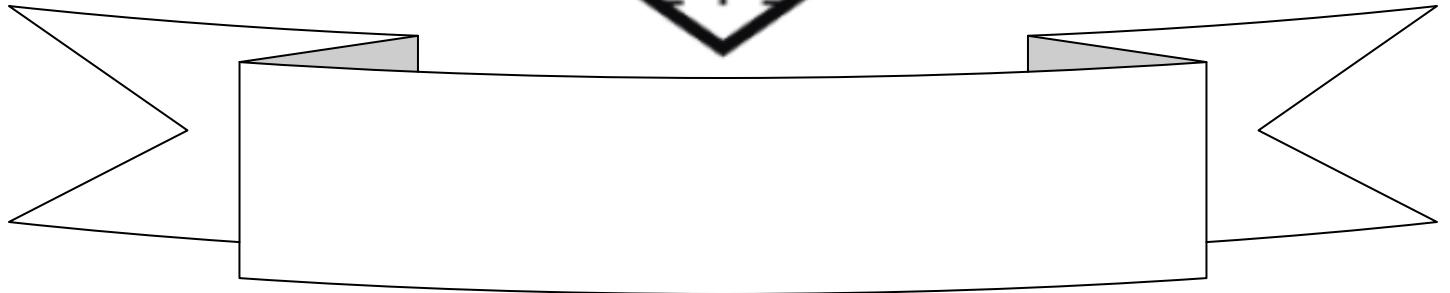
With my friends around me and my love beside me,
